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REQUIREMENTS FOR DMS PROGRAMS

• GENERAL REQUIREMENTS •

- Meet all University of Rio Grande/Rio Grande Community College admission requirements and be officially admitted to the University by the application deadline.
- DMS application form must have supporting documentation attached to it and must be presented to the DMS director in an envelope by April 1, 2021. Incomplete applications will not be considered for admission into the program. Supporting documentation includes high school transcripts and/or college transcripts, ACT scores, and copies of degrees or certifications earned in an Allied Health area (if applicable). Unofficial copies may be used for this application.
- DMS Applications Are Only Good For One Year. You Must Reapply Each Year.
- After Students Are Chosen For The Next Academic Year, All Applications Will Be Discarded.

• ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS •

ACT -

- If you graduated from high school in 2016 or later, the ACT is required with a composite score of 20 or higher; math and science scores of 19 preferred, but not required.
- If you graduated from high school in 2015 or earlier, you can take the ACT or receive “life experience” points.
Mandatory Prerequisite:
- High school or college algebra with a “C” or higher.
- High school or college biology with a “C” or higher.
- High school or college chemistry with a “C” or higher.

High school or college GPA of 2.5 (minimum requirement) based on general courses.

All Allied Health programs are subject to random drug/alcohol testing, and BCI and FBI background checks. Students are also required to complete CPR certification in the semester prior to their first clinical rotation (scheduled by the DMS faculty). Students are responsible for all testing fees.
